



Quiet Reflection and Preparation for Worship:

What if God's call is not to go "back to normal" but to go forward with Christ? In what direction is your life moving? Are you going backwards to your old life, or forward into the Spirit's new adventure? Consider this morning what your next step towards God might be, and commit to strain forward to what lies ahead.

Welcome & Announcements

Call to Worship:

When Jesus saw the crowds, he went up on the mountain; and after he sat down, his disciples came to him. Then he began to speak, and taught them, saying:

Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

***Call to Confession:** Psalm 14:2

"The LORD looks down from heaven on humankind to see if there are any who are wise, who seek after God." The response is not positive; "there is no one who does good, no, not one." Psalm 14 reminds us that all have sinned and fallen short of the glory of God. Therefore, let us together confess our sins and trust in Christ.

*Prayer of Confession:

Normally we are hesitant to admit our flaws and failings. But when confronted with you, O God, we cannot help but see our sins in stark contrast with your gracious love. Forgive us for our spiritual pride. Forgive us for imagining that we might not need a savior, or that our sins are too small to regard. We know that there is no one who does good, who is good, without your grace and forgiveness. Help us to rely upon your strength, and not our own; your righteousness, and not our own; your goodness, and not our own. Then may we too rise with Christ, making a mockery of the powers of sin and death, and exalting the name of Jesus of Nazareth.
