

*Call to Confession:

We can acknowledge that we did not follow these commandments perfectly this week. Join me in confession our failings to God and to one another.

*Prayer of Confession:

Your expectations, O Lord God, are not so high that we cannot attain them, or so deep that we cannot discern them. You have told us what righteousness looks like; to love You, and to love our neighbors made in your image. But the selflessness required for that love has sometimes eluded us.

In the name of Jesus, forgive us our selfish choices. Grow our hearts and our capacity to love, so that we might discover ourselves just as you intended us to be.
