

Quiet Reflection and Preparation for Worship:

Where does God's vision compliment or conflict with the dreams you have for yourself, or the expectations others have for you? The love of God for sinners and the inclusion of the unexpected in the kingdom gives us pause when we are not the subjects of that grace. Let us therefore make our confession together.

*Prayer of Confession:

Your mercy, O Lord, when directed at us, is the very source of hope and joy in our lives. Yet we are hesitant when you extend that mercy to others. We set expectations for others that exceed our own abilities. At times, we are reluctant to share this space and community, for fear that it might change. We easily slip into the world's habit of valuing insiders over newcomers, and "us" over "them."

But the kingdom in which we want to live is different from those of this world. Change our hearts to fit your kingdom, O Lord. Help us to celebrate your generosity and grace to others as much or more than we do for ourselves. Help us to rejoice with the angels at the inclusion of the lost, and to find our purpose in giving away what we have been given.
