*Call to Confession: Luke 14:34-35

Jesus says, "Salt is good; but if salt has lost its taste, how can its saltiness be restored? It is fit neither for the soil nor for the manure pile; they throw it away." We are the salt of the earth, but we risk losing what makes us distinctive when we stray from our Savior. Let us instead return to Jesus using our prayer of confession.

*Prayer of Confession:

Lord Jesus, you instruct us to weigh the cost of the Christian life. While we would prefer an easy religion of comfort and convenience, you offer us something different. You call us to be different, to be holy. You ask us to carry the cross and follow you.

Often we have sought alternative routes to you, detours that did not involve our own crosses. We had hoped this would be a victorious path and not just a virtuous one. Yet each of those broad and easy paths have led us away from you.

Forgive us again for the ways we have blended in with the world around us, losing our distinctiveness, our saltiness. You alone can make us salty again. Work your redemption in our lives today. To you we confess, in you we trust, with you we serve, and for you we live.
