The second candle of Advent is the candle of peace. Jesus comes as the Prince of Peace to usher in God's Shalom.

We light this candle in recognition that even now, Christ brings peace, uniting tribes and languages and peoples and nations.

*Call to Confession: Ephesians 2:1-3

We were once "dead through the trespasses and sins in which we once lived, following the course of this world, following the ruler of the power of the air, the spirit that is now at work in the disobedient. All of us once lived among them in the passions of the flesh, following the desires of flesh and senses, and we were by nature children of wrath, like everyone else." But now that we have begun a new life in Christ, we confess our sins to each other and so avoid re-living our history. Let us pray.

*Prayer of Confession:

Father, Son and Spirit - You have already redeemed us from the sins of our

past, present and future. Yet we do not always act as a redeemed people. When desires of our flesh and senses work to isolate us from you, let our repentance and your grace draw us back.

We not only draw away from you; we also divide from one another. Forgive us for discounting or dismissing others, especially our Christian sisters and brothers, over differences that are human-made distinctions – race, politics, denomination, nationality, etc. As you abolish the power of sin, so too abolish the sin of division, and make us one again in Christ our Lord.

(We keep a moment of silence for reflection)

*Assurance of Pardon:

Ephesians 2:4-6

This is the gospel: "God, who is rich in mercy, out of the great love with which he loved us even when we were dead through our trespasses, made us alive together with Christ – by grace you have been saved – and raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus." <u>TODAY'S COMMUNION</u>—Today we will celebrate the Sacrament of Communion. To participate at home, please have your juice and bread ready and available for today's live stream service. In-person worshippers will have prepackaged elements available to them.
