

Quiet Reflection and Preparation for Worship:

What if God's call is not to go "back to normal" but to go forward with Christ? In what direction is your life moving? Are you going backwards to your old life, or forward into the Spirit's new adventure? Consider this morning what your next step towards God might be, and commit to strain forward to what lies ahead.

Call to Worship:

When Jesus saw the crowds, he went up on the mountain; and after he sat down, his disciples came to him. Then he began to speak, and taught them, saying:

Blessed are those who are persecuted for righteousness' sake, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven.

Blessed are you when people revile you and persecute you and utter all kinds of evil against you falsely on my account.

Rejoice and be glad, for your reward is great in heaven, for in the same way they persecuted the prophets who were before you.

*Call to Confession:

In Daniel 6, Daniel is arrested for practicing his faith, but refuses to stop. In Acts 5, the apostles are arrested and beaten, and they give thanks for the honor of suffering for Jesus. Our path as a church is much easier than Daniel's, or the apostles', but they raise an important question: if following Jesus was illegal, would you be convicted? Let us reflect on this as together we offer our prayer of confession.

*Prayer of Confession:

Lord Jesus, we pray today that we could be found worthy of suffering for your name. We want to live out your radical message of grace, hope and love in such a way as to make the world uncomfortable. Forgive us for all the ways we allow ourselves to be conformed to our world; instead, transform us today by the renewing of our minds. Too often we simply blend in; today, we pray you would help us to stand out – to be different.

Holiness is a standard we cannot attain on our own; but through the power of the Holy Spirit, we know it is possible to live obediently to you, and to make life-changing invitations for others to do the same. Guide us to the next steps of our own relationship with you, and place on our hearts today the names of those to whom we are being sent, as ambassadors of your heavenly kingdom.
