*Call to Confession:

Scripture reminds us that our sin not only separates us from God; it also separates us from one another. God's good design of one human family has been divided so often that we sometimes don't remember we are all kin. Recognizing the sin that separates us, we join our voices together as one family to make our prayer of confession.

*Prayer of Confession:

Father God, from whom all families on heaven and earth take their names, your good design was for us to be one, as you, the Son, and the Spirit are one. But from the beginning we have fought, separated, and divided from our brothers and sisters. As individuals and as communities, we have allowed sin to drive us apart from those who should be family.

We repent of our sinful choices this week. Make us a new family, bound together not by our blood but by the blood of Christ; united not by human kingdoms but by the kingdom of God. Stretch our hearts by your Spirit so that we might learn to love our neighbors as you have loved us.
