This final third of the Gospel of Mark is the final week of Jesus' pre-resurrection life, and includes his ultimate victory over sin and death. In this season of Lent, where do you need to experience deliverance from evil? What would it look like for you to partner with Jesus in this work of deliverance?

#### \*Prayer of Confession:

Jesus, we are a people desperate to be right. Our desire to be right far outstrips our desire to be righteous. But today we acknowledge that we are quite wrong.

We have acted wrongly, thought wrongly, and even wrongly tried to earn your love. We have wrongly sought human honor and wrongly kept back our wealth from your service. Forgive us, O Christ. Deliver us from evil without and within, in your holy name.
