

#### Welcome and Explanation

Call to Worship Luke 9:23-24

Jesus said: If any of you want to be my disciples, take up the cross and follow me.

Those who seek to save their lives will lose them, but those who give their lives for Christ's sake will be saved.

### Communal Prayer:

O Merciful Father, you sent your Son to be our Savior. You sent him as Light into our darkness; yet we tried to extinguish him. You sent him as your Word into our silence, yet we tried to quiet him. You sent him as Life into our dying, yet we killed him.

Too often, we belittle our sins, and in so doing, belittle his sacrifice. "So many others have done worse," we say, as if that makes our sin more palatable. We claim that we are only minor characters, unable to do great good or great evil.

Yet tonight, we find ourselves faced with the truth. There are no little sins, and there are no minor characters in this story. Have mercy on this fallen world; Lord, have mercy on us.
