

MAUNDY THURSDAY SERVICE

Maundy Thursday is the Thursday before Easter on which Christians memorialize the last supper Jesus ate with his disciples. "Maundy" comes from the Latin "mandatum novum," meaning "new commandment. In John 13:34, Jesus gives the disciples a new commandment; "Love one another."

Call to Worship: Luke 22:1-8

Now the Festival of Unleavened Bread, which is called Passover, was near.

The chief priests and the scribes were looking for a way to put Jesus to death, for they were afraid of the people.

Then Satan entered into Judas called Iscariot, who was one of the twelve; he went away and conferred with the chief priests and officers of the temple police about how he might betray him to them. They were greatly pleased and agreed to give him money.

So he consented and began to look for an opportunity to betray him to them when no crowd was present.

Then came the day of Unleavened Bread, on which the Passover lamb had to be sacrificed. So Jesus sent Peter and John, saying,

"Go and prepare the Passover meal for us that we may eat it."
