<u>CCPC BUILDING CLOSED</u>—Due to the Governor's executive order to close all non-essential businesses, the church building will be closed for the foreseeable future. COMMUNION IN YOUR HOME!—For today's service, Maundy Thursday (April 9), and Easter Sunday (April 12), we will celebrate the Sacrament of Communion. To participate in Communion at any or all of these services, you will need to purchase grape juice and bread! Since we don't drink a lot of juice for communion, one bottle should be more than sufficient per family. Any kind of grape juice or bread will work. Please have your juice and bread ready and available when you tune in to each of those services! We will explain what to do at the beginning of each worship time.

If you are not shopping for groceries this week, you can utilize "sacred substitutes" at your discretion (remember that Jesus turned water into wine anyway). More important than purchasing specific elements for the service is remaining safe and keeping others safe.

HOLY WEEK SERVICES—Join us on our live-stream next week for our Maundy Thursday service at 6:30pm. This service will include communion, so be prepared with grape juice and bread. Then, tune in again on Friday, April 10, for our Good Friday service at 6:30pm. If possible, plan to worship in a space where you can darken the room. More to follow next week on each of these special services!

LIVE STREAM GREETINGS!—The unfortunate reality of this season of adaptation is that we cannot physically come together, see the smiles of our brothers and sisters in Christ, and embrace each other with a hug or handshake. Our Sunday mornings are for the worship of the Most High, but it also is for the relationships we've been blessed with in our faith family.

Though there is nothing that compares to being together, we want to create a sense of community through our live stream service. We invite everyone to send a 10-second or shorter video greeting from yourself, or your entire family. Every Sunday morning during the worship live stream, we will play a handful of these greetings for all to see! Please go to

<u>ONLINE GIVING</u>—Please consider continuing your regular giving online by going to clicking on the button below the live stream window. When you give, you can choose to make a one time donation, or setup a reoccurring gift.

Online giving options include either ACH Bank Transfer (also known as e-checks) or with a debit or credit card. You can also give via Apple Pay - a more secure means of online giving than the traditional credit card method.

As a member or regular visitor, you are already in our database. So, when you give online, please enter your individual first and last name (i.e. Jim Gates, not Jim and Krista Gates). This will allow the computer to automatically match your gift with your profile.

You can also choose to log in to see your donation history or your reoccurring gifts. Just click the smiley face emoji on the top right hand corner of the giving

page, and select "log in." Enter your cell phone and the system will send you back a 6-digit code to confirm your identity. Enter that code and then you have access to your personal giving history and previous donation methods (i.e. a saved bank account for ACH transfer).
