

Judah, in speaking with Joseph, says, "What can we say to my lord? What can we speak? How can we clear ourselves? God has found out the guilt of your servants; here we are then, my lord's slaves, both we and also the one in whose possession the cup has been found." We are also those whose guilt is not hidden from God. Knowing this, we make our prayer of confession.

### \*Prayer of Confession:

Like Joseph's brothers stood wordlessly and hopelessly before Joseph, so too we, the brothers and sisters of Jesus, stand before Jesus today. You, O God, have found out our guilt, and no defense of our own can clear our names. And yet we do not come without hope; for we know that our brother has already offered forgiveness and life to us. We turn again from our old behaviors, and turn towards you, Father. May we judge no cost too high for our repentance, as you judged no cost too high for our salvation.
