*Call to Confession:

Our world instructs us to retreat from our confidence, our faith, our hope, and our love. But God calls us to "strain forward to what lies ahead." This week we have struggled to ignore the voices calling us to move backwards from God. Let us therefore offer our prayer of confession, so that we might move forward, together.

*Prayer of Confession:

Lord Jesus, throughout the pandemic, our common refrain and deep desire has been to go back to normal. But going backwards takes us back to our mistakes, back to our painful history, back to our old habits. Like the Israelites in the wilderness, we are sometimes so frightened about what is before us that we forget how far we have come, and how much you have already done.

Grant us the ability to forget what lies behind, and to strain forward to your coming kingdom, even when that seems more like a raging sea than dry ground. Show us who we are to become in You, and grant us the prize of the heavenly call of God in Christ Jesus, our Lord.
