After the people of Israel asked for a human king "like other nations," "the LORD said to Samuel, 'listen to the voice of the people in all that they say to you; for they have not rejected you, but they have rejected me from being king over them." We have also rejected God's kingship over us this week, and so we gather in prayer together.

*Prayer of Confession:

Blessed are you, O Lord our God, King of the universe. You reign in heaven, and we in the church are those who accept and honor You as our King on earth.

Yet like our ancestors, we question whether you are the King for us. We know the extraordinary benefits of living in your kingdom, but we want to keep our options open for other ways of living. We realize you are all-wise, yet we think that in some situations, we might know better than you. We prefer leaders we can see and touch to the guidance of your Spirit.

Forgive us for our arrogance and disloyalty. Forgive us for wanting to place others, or ourselves, on the thrones of our lives. Thank you for sending Jesus, the King who understands our failings, and who has already atoned for our sins. May we honor him with our lives today.
