

Call to Worship: Acts 26:23

Today we testify with the same message as the prophets and the saints: **That the Messiah must suffer,**

And that, by being the first to rise from the dead,

He would proclaim light both to Jews and Gentiles.

Now we proclaim the holy mystery:

Christ has died, Christ is risen, Christ will come again.

*Call to Confession: Acts 26:9

Paul confesses that he did "many things against the name of Jesus of Nazareth." This week, we too have dishonored his name by our sinful thoughts and acts. Therefore, we join together in our prayer of confession.

*Prayer of Confession:

Holy God, your mercies are new every morning. Do a new thing in us today. Although we have not followed you with complete devotion, you have loved us with complete abandon. Although we have not fully honored the name of Jesus, you claim by name as your children. Wake us up to the extravagance of your grace, so that we might turn away from our old lives and live entirely for and with you. This we pray in the mighty name of Jesus of Nazareth.

(We keep a moment of silence for reflection)

*Assurance of Pardon:

Acts 26:18

Jesus said to Paul, "I am sending you to open their eyes so that they may turn from darkness to light and from the power of Satan to God, so that they may receive forgiveness of sins and a place among those who are sanctified by faith in me." We are those who have received the gospel, the forgiveness of our sins, and a place among the saints in Christ. Thanks be to him! **Amen!**

RETURNING TO IN-PERSON WORSHIP SERVICE—After much prayerful deliberation, our Session has approved a plan for returning to in-person worship services in the month of July. You will see a great deal of communication from us in coming weeks with more details on what this reopening will look like. But for now, here's a brief outline of our plan:

- We will offer TWO worship services, at 9am and 11am, for those who wish to worship together in the Sanctuary.
- One service (9am) will be "masks required"; the other service (11am) will be "masks optional".
- We will limit attendance at each service to 100 people in the Sanctuary, and reservations will be required for each service (made on the website or via phone).
- No ID, Nursery, Kid's Worship or Fellowship Hour will be offered initially just worship!
- Worship itself will be different to accommodate social distancing and best practices in a COVID-19 world. This means, sadly, no handshakes or congregational singing as we begin.
- Online worship WILL CONTINUE for all who wish to worship that way, and we especially encourage all who are vulnerable to continue to worship via our live-stream.
