

Quiet Reflection and Preparation for Worship:

Paul says, "And so, brothers and sisters, I could not speak to you as spiritual people, but rather as people of the flesh, as infants in Christ. I fed you with milk, not solid food, for you were not ready for solid food. Even now you are still not ready, for you are still of the flesh. For as long as there is jealousy and quarreling among you, are you not of the flesh, and behaving according to human inclinations? For when one says, "I belong to Paul," and another, "I belong to Apollos," are you not merely human?" We too come to confess that we have been people of the flesh, and merely human, this week.

*Prayer of Confession:

Holy Spirit, you came to make us new – new creations and new temples in which you would dwell, transforming us from merely human to something greater. But we have drifted backwards to old patterns, to worldly accommodations, and to fleshly desires. You desire to give us solid food, and find us still requiring milk – the most basic proclamations of truths we should already practice.

Spirit, we want to partner with you today in a fresh way. Help us to turn away from our old lives and build upon the unshakeable foundation of the good news of Jesus Christ. Grow our faith, hope and love so that we can become a truly spiritual people.
