

# Gathering Around the Word

## Quiet Reflection and Preparation for Worship:

This year we will read through the Book of Acts together, considering how the story of the early church might shape and guide our own congregation's story. Like Acts itself, we are Unfinished. #### Welcome & Announcements

Call to Worship: Isaiah 6:1-3

In the year that King Uzziah died, Isaiah saw the Lord, high and exalted, seated on a throne; and the train of his robe filled the temple. Above him were seraphim, each with six wings ... and they were calling to one another:

Holy, holy is the LORD Almighty; the whole earth is full of his glory."

\*Hymn: "Holy, Holy, Lord God Almighty" (vs. 1,4) #1

\*Call to Confession: Isaiah 6:5

When Isaiah encountered the Lord, he cried, "Woe to me! I am ruined! For I am a man of unclean lips, and I live among a people of unclean lips, and my eyes have seen the King, the LORD Almighty." Like Isaiah, when we behold the goodness of God, our sins become all the more apparent. Let us, too, confess those sins to God.

## \*Prayer of Confession:

Triune God, your very identity models for us perfect love, peace and unity. In the union of Father, Son and Spirit we come to understand rightly-ordered love. But we are also reminded of how very far from that union we remain. In our country today, we know that issues of race, class and history maintain deep divisions. In our communities and workplaces, long standing grievances dampen our passion for your grace. Even with our friends and families, we often struggle to reflect the love that defines your relationship, O Three-in-One.

Forgive us for the selfishness and divisions that separate us from one another and from you. Inspire us to the radical love of others that triumphs over sin, a love embodied in our Savior Jesus. May we follow his example, even as we are forgiven by his grace.

#### \*Assurance of Pardon:

Isaiah 6:6-7

Isaiah writes, "then one of the seraphim flew to me with a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with tongs from the altar. With it he touched my mouth and said, "See, this has touched your lips; your guilt is taken away and your sin atoned for." Believe the gospel; Jesus is the fire of God that takes away our sins and makes us righteous before God. Thanks be to him! **Amen!**
