

I do not want you to be unaware, brothers and sisters, that our ancestors were all under the cloud, and all passed through the sea,

And all were baptized into Moses in the cloud and in the sea, and all ate the same spiritual food, and all drank the same spiritual drink.

For they drank from the spiritual rock that followed them, and that rock was Christ. Sharing in the baptism of Christ, partaking of the body and blood of Christ, we come to celebrate Jesus our Rock. Let us worship him!

*Call to Confession:

1 Corinthians 10:5-12

In 1 Corinthians 5-12, Paul reminds us that our ancestors, despite being baptized in the cloud and sea, despite being sustained with spiritual food and drink, still displeased God and were struck down in the wilderness. "Now these things occurred as examples for us, so that we might not desire evil as they did. Do not become idolaters as some of them did ... we must not engage in sexual immorality as some of them did ... we must not put Christ to the test, as some of them did ... and do not complain, as some of them did ... for these things happened to them to serve as an example, and they were written down to instruct us, on whom the ends of the ages have come. So if you think you are standing, watch out that you do not fall." Recognizing the example of our ancestors and our own failings, let us join together in prayer.

*Prayer of Confession:

Like our spiritual mothers and fathers, we have stumbled and sinned. We have not learned from their examples, but have repeated their stories in our lives. Forgive us, O God.

Our confidence and strength to remain standing before you, Father, comes not from our righteousness, but from what we have received in Christ. All have fallen, save the One Man; but we who chose to live in that One Man, remain standing in Him. Praise be to you, O God, for the One who never failed or fell!
