

Quiet Reflection and Preparation for Worship:

This summer we "Return from Exile" with the people in the Book of Ezra. This is a long journey, not merely a single event. Have you had an experience of exile? How are you called to return to a spiritual life? Return to church? Return to God? What first steps can you take today on that long journey home to Christ?

Scripture reminds us to "Consider him who endured such hostility against himself from sinners, so that you may not grow weary or lose heart. In your struggle against sin you have not yet resisted to the point of shedding your blood." This week we have not fully turned to Christ and away from our sins. Therefore, let us confess our sins together. Please pray these words in your heart as I speak them aloud.

*Prayer of Confession:

Father God, we confess that we have not struggled against sin this week with all our hearts. In our own life, we have made only half-hearted efforts to abolish our selfish, sinful behaviors. In our world, we have opted to compromise with systems of injustice rather than to risk our comfort by opposing them.

Forgive us for our starts and stops of obedience. Fix our eyes on Jesus again today, and let us follow him faithfully, laying aside the weight and the sin that clings so closely, so that we can run with perseverance the race that is set before us. This we ask in Jesus' holy and precious name.

ANNOUNCEMENTS

WORSHIP RETURNING TO ONE SERVICE—On August 2, we will return to our 10am worship hour for both online and in-person worship. This will be our format for at least August and September. For our in-person worshippers, we will maintain our current precautions (making reservations, social distancing in the Sanctuary, and refraining from congregational singing) with one change. **Starting** August 2, we will ask that everyone who attends in person wear a mask. This is becoming more and more commonplace (even Wal-Mart requires masks!) and increasingly feels essential given our higher-risk population and hour-long service. If you would like to attend in person but have medical conditions that prevent you from mask wearing, please contact Jim Gates (jim@covenantcommunitypc.org). Children and Youth programming will remain online-only for August and September (except for outside youth programming, which may occur in-person provided social distancing is maintained). Beginning in August, adult programming (Bible Studies, Committees, etc) may opt to meet in person in the building provided that participants wear masks and social distance. Zoom options must be offered for all such programming for those who would prefer to remain at home. Each adult group may make their own decisions whether to offer online-only options, or a blended in-person and online option.
