*Call to Confession:

1 John 1:5-7

John writes, "This is the message we have heard from him and proclaim to you, that God is light and in him there is no darkness at all. If we say we have fellowship with him while we are walking in darkness, we lie and do not do what is true; but if we walk in the light as he himself is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son cleanses us from all sin. Let us bring our sins into the light, before God and one another.

*Prayer of Confession:

Even in the beginning, O Lord, you had a plan for our world and a design for our lives. You loved us from the start, making us in your image and according to your likeness. But we have stained that image with our selfish thoughts and actions this week. We should reflect the light of Christ to the world, but sometimes we chose instead to hide in darkness.

Give us a new beginning, Father, and help us treasure your image in ourselves and in each person around us. Let us rest in your grace today, through the power of Jesus your Son, our Savior.
