

\*Call to Confession: Philippians 3:3

While self-confidence is good, self-centered confidence is quite different. When we live convinced of our own perfection, we have no room for grace and no need for Christ. This is why Paul reminds us that we "who worship in the Spirit of God and boast in Christ Jesus ... have no confidence in the flesh." Let us therefore join together in prayer and confess our imperfections to God.

### \*Prayer of Confession:

Lord Jesus, we confess that we sometimes see ourselves as more righteous than we truly are. We easily believe the lie that we "have it together" simply because our imperfections are easier to disguise than those of others. Self-centered confidence comes all too naturally to us, as it did to the Pharisees of old.

Today we recant the falsehood that we can be "good enough" without you. Jesus, your redemption is not just for others; we need your grace and mercy ourselves today. Thank you for loving us and redeeming us with your life, despite our sin. May we always place our confidence in you and you alone.
