### GATHERING AROUND THE WORD

#### Quiet Reflection and Preparation for Worship:

Scripture challenges us to walk by faith, not by sight; to see the world through the eyes of Christ. What present, and future, does Jesus see when looking at our world? At your life? Where does God's vision compliment or conflict with the dreams you have for yourself, or the expectations others have for you? Prayerfully reflect this morning on how you might come to see God's vision with greater clarity.

#### \*Call to Confession:

Nehemiah reminds us that throughout our history we have sinned in cycles. We sin, we repent, we repeat. Today, we come not only to repent, but to seek to break the cycle of sin and live wholly with Christ. To that end, let us join together in prayer.

### \*Prayer of Confession:

Like wayward children, O LORD, we have seized the reigns of our lives from you, only relinquishing them when it is clear we cannot maintain control on our own. We earnestly repent in our moments of crisis or insight, but then quickly return to our self-oriented lives when those moments pass. Forgive us for failing to step out of the cycle of sin.

Lord Jesus, you came as the embodiment of God's grace, to break this cycle and free us to live fully as You intended. Shock us with the magnitude of that grace today, so that we will not return to old patterns, but begin to live as new creations. Holy Spirit, equip us to live, love, and forgive as little Christs today.
