MAUNDY THURSDAY SERVICE

April 1, 2021

Maundy Thursday is the Thursday before Easter on which Christians memorialize the last supper Jesus ate with his disciples. "Maundy" comes from the Latin "mandatum novum," meaning "new commandment. In John 13:34, Jesus gives the disciples a new commandment; "Love one another."

Prelude: "More Precious Than Silver/Oh, How He Loves You and Me" Les Fraaza

Call to Worship: Matthew 26:17-19

On the first day of Unleavened Bread the disciples came to Jesus, saying,

"Where do you want us to make the preparations for you to eat the Passover?"

He said, "Go into the city to a certain man, and say to him,

'The Teacher says, My time is near; I will keep the Passover at your house with my disciples.'"

So the disciples did as Jesus had directed them, and they prepared the Passover meal.

Setting the Table: Processional During Hymn

Gathering Hymn:

"Jesu, Jesu, Fill Us with Your Love" (vs. 1,3,4)

Opening Prayer:

Our Table is set, Lord Jesus, but it is incomplete without you. Come and be our host.

Our lives feel full, O Lord, but they are empty without you. Come and be our Lord.

Our world is busy, O God, but without you it is purposeless. Come and be our King.

Disturb our comfort and awaken our hearts tonight, O Lord.

Through the waters of the Red Sea, through the waters of our baptism, bring us out of our empty tables, lives and world, and give us a seat at your table, a share in your life, a place in your kingdom. Lord Jesus, make room for us tonight.

Silent Confession

Assurance of Pardon: Psalm 41:9-12

"Even my close friend in whom I trusted, who ate of my bread, has lifted the heel against me. But you, O LORD, be gracious to me, and raise me up, that I may repay them. By this I know that you are pleased with me; because my enemy has not triumphed over me. But you have upheld me because of my integrity, and set me in your presence forever." Thanks be to God! Amen.
