Maundy Thursday is the Thursday before Easter on which Christians memorialize the last supper Jesus ate with his disciples. "Maundy" comes from the Latin "mandatum novum," meaning "new commandment. In John 13:34, Jesus gives the disciples a new commandment; "Love one another."

Liturgy and Prayer - Mark 14:27-31

"You will all fall away," Jesus told them, for it is written: 'I will strike the shepherd, and the sheep will be scattered.' But after I have risen, I will go ahead of you into Galilee."

But I declared, "Even if all fall away, I will not."

"Truly I tell you," Jesus answered, "today- yes, tonight- before the rooster crows twice you yourself will disown me three times."

But I insisted emphatically, "Even if I have to die with you, I will never disown you."

Yet still we have turned away from you, denied you, rejected you as our Lord. In what we have done, and in what we have left undone, we have denied knowing you, Jesus, as our Lord and as our Savior. We have slept through that which causes you sorrow, and fled when you called us to stand. Truly you have said, "The spirit is willing, but the flesh is weak." Forgive us. Have mercy on us. Amen.
